Important Awards & Abstract Submission

Last Date for Abstract Submission: **30th October 2026**

Late abstracts will not be entertained.

We are pleased to announce the following awards and opportunities:



A competitive award for graduates who have completed their MS within the past five years. The presenter must be the first author of the paper. The recipient will be offered a **2-week fellowship with AMASI in India.**



Reserved for residents currently pursuing their MS, MCh, or NBMS program in Nepal or abroad. The presenter must be the first author, and submission must include a letter from the head of institute/department confirming residency status. The recipient will have the opportunity to attend the **College of Surgeons of Sri Lanka Conference in September 2027**, along with a **1-2 week fellowship.**



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Abstract Submission Policies

- ▶ SSNCON2026 invites papers that are original and novel.
- ▶ Papers previously presented at a National or International meeting/conference will not be accepted.
- ▶ Papers presented locally (institutional or departmental) may be submitted with a proper declaration.
- ▶ Papers must not duplicate previously presented data, unless the new submission adds more than 50% new data — covered by a proper declaration.
- ▶ **The last date of abstract submission is 30th October 2026. Late abstracts will not be entertained.**
- ▶ All abstracts must be submitted through the SSNCON2026 website.
- ▶ All presenters must complete their conference registration. Accepted abstracts will be retracted if the presenter has not registered by the final registration date.

Abstract Format

- ▶ 250-word limit (excludes title, author names, and institutional affiliations)
- ▶ All authors must be listed in order; the presenting author must be separately identified
- ▶ All abstracts must display institutional affiliations for every author
- ▶ Structured format required: **Introduction, Methods, Results, Conclusion**
- ▶ **Keywords:** 3-6, in alphabetical order, preferably using MeSH terms

Submission Categories

Guest Lectures	250-word limit (excludes title, author names, and institutional affiliations)
Award Papers Young Surgeons Award	(see Awards section above)
Award Papers — Resident Best Paper Award	(see Awards section above)
Free Papers	All other submissions not qualifying for guest lectures or award categories. Same submission policies apply.

Posters

- ▶ Same submission policies and guidelines as oral presentations
- ▶ Some oral submissions may be reassigned to poster presentation by the Scientific Committee, depending on relevance and submission volume
- ▶ **All posters will be presented in e-poster format** — dimensions and design specifications to be provided subsequently
- ▶ Posters assessed by judges on presentation day; presenter must be present at the poster display area at the specified date and time
- ▶ Best Poster Award announced at the end of the conference
